Overview

The HEERF Student Emergency Grants provide emergency financial assistance to eligible students who are experiencing hardship which could adversely affect their educational success. This emergency financial aid grant may be used for any component of the student's cost of attendance or for emergency costs that arise due to coronavirus, such as tuition, food, housing, health care (including mental health care) or childcare.

- Students must be able to demonstrate a genuine financial hardship and exceptional need.
- Students are eligible for up to \$500 in Emergency Grant award.

Qualifications

- Students must be enrolled for the Spring 2021 semester
- Students must have a current emergency need
- Students must demonstrate an ability and intention to complete their course of study

Terms & Conditions

- Emergency grants are subject to financial availability, and The School of Labor and Urban Studies reserves the right to reduce or rescind any scholarship or award if financial circumstances dictate.
- Emergency Grants may not be deferred. Recipients must use the grant in the year(s) for which it is awarded.



Application Review

- The School of Labor and Urban Studies ensures that the emergency grant committee reviews applications based on the criteria of the emergency grant eligibility requirements and the supporting documentation included with all completed emergency grant applications.

Award Information & Notification

- Grant recipients will be notified of award via their School of Labor and Urban Studies email account.
- For emergency grant awards, if approved, there is generally a 7-10 business day turnaround time from review of a complete application to emergency grant award processing.
