Overview

The HEERF Student Emergency Scholarships provide emergency financial assistance to eligible students at Minority Serving Institutions (MSI) who are experiencing hardship which could adversely affect their educational success. This scholarship may be used for any component of the student's cost of attendance or for emergency costs that arise due to coronavirus, such as tuition, food, housing, health care (including mental health care) or childcare.

Students must be able to demonstrate a genuine financial hardship and exceptional need.

Students are eligible for up to \$1000 in MSI Scholarship awards.

Qualifications

- Students must be enrolled for the Spring 2021 semester
- Students must have a current emergency need
- Students must demonstrate an ability and intention to complete their course of study

Terms & Conditions

- MSI Scholarships are subject to financial availability, and The School of Labor and Urban Studies reserves the right to reduce or rescind any scholarship or award if financial circumstances dictate.
- MSI Scholarships may not be deferred. Recipients must use the scholarships in the year(s) for which it is awarded.



Application Review

The School of Labor and Urban Studies ensures that the MSI scholarship committee reviews applications based on the criteria of the scholarship eligibility requirements and the supporting documentation included with all completed scholarship applications.
