Careers with Federal Agency - Social Security Administration

Social Security Administration's (SSA) New York Regional Office is recruiting for a variety of entry level positions including:

- Customer Service Representative Field Office or Program Service Center, providing the public with information about SSA's programs and services, reviewing and evaluating information to determine eligibility for the benefits SSA administers, and updating records using SSA's computer systems.
- Legal Administrative Specialist Claims Examining or Benefit Authorizer, resolving issues or discrepancies in Social Security records and explaining program information both orally and in writing. BAs analyze records to make benefit determinations and research policy before making computer inputs to process actions that are not able to be automated.
- Claims Specialist Field Office, conducting interviews to obtain, clarify and verify information for initial eligibility for various benefits. In addition, resolve discrepancies, clarify issues, and make final decisions for initial and postentitlement benefits and payments; adjudicate entitlement or disallowance actions; and use SSA's computer systems to access and update claims information.
