Leadership for Democracy and Social Justice is a joint initiative between the Colin Powell School for Civic and Global Leadership at City College of New York and the CUNY School of Labor and Urban Studies. The 2024 cohort of Career Empowerment Mentors will have the opportunity to partner with civically minded, early social sector leaders to ensure they have access to the knowledge and resources needed to thrive in the complex field of social change and movement building. This is a paid opportunity. Selected mentors will receive \$3,000 for approximately 6 hours of virtual group mentorship and 9 hours of one-on-one mentorship to occur over a 6-month period (from June-November 2024). Selected mentors will be matched with a small pod of no more than three mentees.

What is the Emerging Leader Fellowship?

The challenges of our times – from racial justice to climate change, economic inequality to health equity, gender justice to LGBTQ+ rights – can only be met by strong, diverse, grounded, and revolutionary leaders who are capable of developing imaginative, innovative, creative, and scalable solutions to achieve social justice.

The Emerging Leaders Fellowship is a semester-long program designed for organizers building power in community organizations, labor unions, or advocacy groups. It begins in August 2024 and concludes in December 2024.

Leadership for Democracy and Social Justice (LDSJ) is pleased to launch the Fall 2024 Regional Organizers for Community (ROCC) Fellowship <u>application</u>.

What is the Regional Organizers for Community Change Fellowship?

The ROCC Fellowships is designed to give established professionals in the social justice sector an opportunity to hone their leadership skills, immerse themselves in theory and practice, and expand their network. This semester-long fellowship provides an intensive cohort experience, granting Fellows the chance to connect and build relationships across issues, take space for reflection, and prepare themselves for the next level of leadership.

The program focuses on leaders working in labor, advocacy, and community organizing with anywhere from 5-15 years of experience. This year, the ROCC Fellowship will focus on leaders in Texas.
