
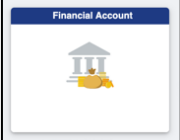
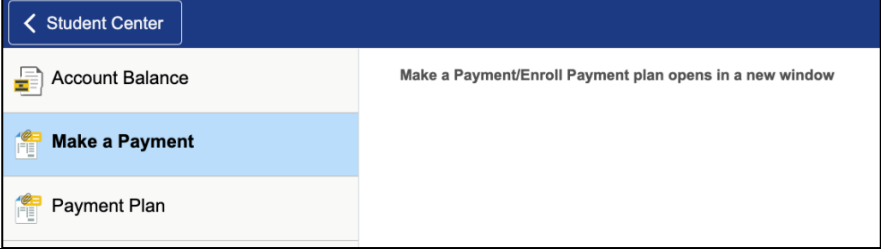
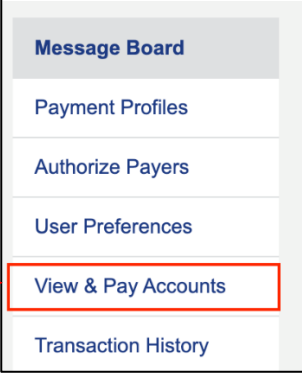
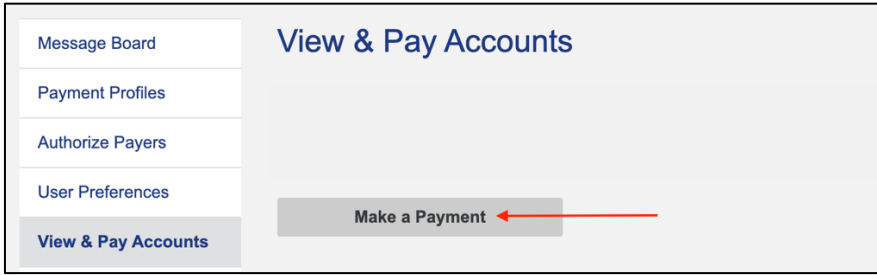




Online payments are quick, easy, and secure!

Debit and Credit Cards: *2.65% non-refundable service fee applied to each transaction.*

Payments are processed by entering your card number, security code, and expiration date as shown on your physical card.

Electronic Check (eCheck): *No fee.*

Payments must be made using your bank account and routing number, which can be obtained from your financial institution. If you have a checkbook, this information is located at the bottom of your check. When selecting eCheck, **do not** enter the debit card number associated with your checking account. This is not your bank account number and is only used to process debit card transactions.

Please carefully verify your account information to ensure successful processing. You are responsible for any returned or rejected payments, including any applicable fees, regardless of the reason.
