The Urban Leadership Program

The Urban Leadership Program at Queens College is a special series of courses subsidized by CWA Local 1180 for members pursuing a degree in labor studies, urban studies, and urban affairs. All courses in the series are offered for college credit and lead to a college degree from Queens College. Evening classes are available.

- Apply your experience as a public service professional to examining and challenging government policy and procedures and developing alternative policy recommendations
- Prepare you for a leadership role in your workplace, union, and community

- Tuition reimbursement of up to \$400 per semester that may be applied to cover the additional credits needed to complete your degree

*Students will be required to participate in a Community Service Project for each semester they are receiving the benefit.
